In addition to the existing bays on Kingsway, new set down and pick up bays have been introduced to serve theatres located in the east of Theatreland.

New bays have been created on Strand and Russell Street to add to the existing facilities, all a short walk from the theatres of St Martin's Lane, Covent Garden, Drury Lane and Aldwych.

We hope the new set down and pick up bays will encourage drivers to drop off and collect passengers from the same convenient location, within a short walking distance of some of Theatreland's most popular venues. The introduction of these bays is the initial phase of a wider coach bay strategy that will be extended across the West End should the pilot scheme at Kingsway, Russell Street and Strand prove successful.
