

## **Audit of Accounts**

### **Notice of public rights**

Audit Commission Act 1998, Sections 14, 15 & 16  
Accounts and Audit Regulations 2011  
Regulations 9, 10, 21 & 22

Notice is given that from 27 June to 22 July 2011, between 9.30am and 4.30pm, any person interested may inspect and make copies of the accounts of Transport for London for the year ended 31 March 2011 and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating to the accounts. The accounts and other documents will be available for inspection at Windsor House or otherwise by arrangement. Application should be made initially to the Chief Finance Officer (see address details below).

Notice is also given that on or after 25 July 2011 at 9.30am until the completion of the audit, the auditor, at the request of a local government elector for any area to which the accounts relate, will give the elector or his/her representative an opportunity to question him about the accounts. Any such elector may make objections to the auditor as to any matter in respect of which the auditor could take action under Section 17 of the Audit Commission Act 1998 (namely, an application to the court for a declaration that an item of account is unlawful) or Section 8 of that Act (namely, immediate and other reports in the public interest).

Any objection must be sent to the auditor in writing and state the grounds of objection. At the same time as the objection is sent to the auditor, a copy of the objection must also be sent to the Chief Finance Officer at Transport for London (Windsor House, 42-50 Victoria Street, London SW1H 0TL).
